

Welcome to the CV- and guidance meeting at IAK

We are inviting you to a meeting with IAK's consultants at Komplement.

See your Danish letter for date, time and place

The meeting will last about 3 hours and consists of a joint meeting and a short individual meeting.

Agenda for the meeting

- Your possibilities while unemployed
- Briefly about job search
- An individual meeting of approx. 10 minutes, during which we acknowledge your CV on Jobnet and talk about your job search.

No later than 2 days before the meeting you must

- Log on to www.mitiak.dk and click on "Registrering af jobsøgning" in the box Møde-aktiviteter - here you have to fill in 2 forms:
 - 1) A joblog- where you state all the jobs you have applied for up till now while you have been unemployed
 - 2) Plan for your job search (you must make a draft)
- You also have to watch a video of approximately 9 minutes duration on mitIAK, during which time we will go through some rules which are important for you to know. If you experience any technical problems you are welcome to contact Michael Ravnsø by phone 3318 4954. You will find the video on the menu at your left under " Video: Vigtige regler for ledige"
- Make sure you have given access to your CV to employers on jobnet.dk and that it can be accessed.
- Go to iak.dk and read about "Dagpengeregler". Also read the list about 9 things you must remember, which we have sent you earlier.

Please note, that in order for you to receive benefits it is a condition that you do all the things mentioned above no later than two days before the meeting.

For the meeting you must bring

- 2 applications and a CV you have sended
- 2 job adverts which you will apply for (note these in your plan for job search too)
- Your CV from jobnet.dk
- Your pin code for mitIIAK (you have to be able to update your plan for job search at mitIAK.dk at the meeting).

Obligation to meet

It is part of your obligation of being available for a job that you participate in the meeting. If you do not turn up you cannot as a rule receive any benefits.

Expenses for transportation

There are no official subsidies for the transportation but IAK has decided to cover your expenses for transport with 1 Dkr. per km. You must remember to state how many km you have to the meeting point when you book a time at mitIAK.

What does it take for us to acknowledge your CV on Jobnet.dk?

There are three minimum demands you must meet:

Give information so the employers can reach you

You have to give clear information about how you can be contacted. We encourage you to give as much information as possible so it will be easy for the employers to get in touch with you. As a minimum you must state your postal code and telephone number.

Make a geographically broad search

It is important that you not only search for a job in the vicinity of your home but expand your search to the whole region or the whole country if necessary. It is, however, an individual judgment how broad geographically you want to search. If you are in doubt what it means for you please contact your contact person at IAK for guidance.

Be realistic and search where the good job opportunities are

We will look to see whether your wishes for a job are within areas with good job opportunities. If you want some guidance within which lines of work the opportunities lie in your region, please contact one of our job consultants at Komplement.

Under "stillingsbetegnelser og kvalifikationer" it is important that the employers can see a full list of all your qualifications within each category (use ticking – but you can also add qualifications yourself).
